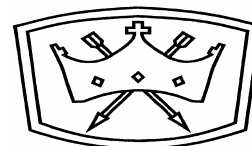

24-HOUR ORGAN MARATHON

As a fund-raiser for our Hall Roofing Fund, Mark Hammond, our organist, will be undertaking a 24-hour Organ Marathon, from 12 noon on Tuesday 15th July to 12 noon on Wednesday 16th July.

Please take one of these sponsor forms and encourage all your friends, neighbours and colleagues to sponsor this event.

The idea is that you get OTHER PEOPLE OUTSIDE THE CONGREGATION to sponsor the event - although of course you can also do so yourself!

We are hoping to raise a substantial sum at this event - as an illustration, if 100 of us each get a total of £20 sponsorship from other people, we will raise £2,000 - but if **ALL** of us each get a total of £50 sponsorship, we will raise nearer £9,000!

See what you can do - among the Under-16s there will be a small prize for the person who gets the most sponsorship.

In addition to this individual sponsorship, Mark is also happy to take requests for specific pieces of music. Requests cost a minimum of £5 each (you may donate as much as you like!), but they must be received by 1st July in order to give Mark sufficient practice time. Requests can be accompanied by a preferred time of playing, and/or a dedication, or, if preferred, a dedication only (i.e. for any piece of music of Mark's choice). Admission to the marathon will be free for most of the time (although there will be plenty of invitations to make donations!), but part (starting at 7.30 pm) of the evening session on Tuesday 15th July will be advertised as a Recital, for which £5 tickets will be available.

To qualify for Gift Aid, what you pay in UK Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax must equal or exceed the amount we will claim in the tax year. All we need is your full name and address and signature, and a tick in the Gift Aid box - that's all there is to it.
